



ADVANCED PLACEMENT STUDIO ART – 3-D DESIGN
GRADES 11 OR 12
ONE CREDIT, ONE YEAR

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course is a college-level course designed for students with above-average ability in art. It is an in-depth studio experience in which students compile a portfolio of quality three-dimensional artwork in accordance with the guidelines established by the Advanced Placement program committee of the College Entrance Examination Board. Students are expected to participate in various art shows and to complete and submit to the College Board a portfolio that demonstrates proficiency in 3-D design using a variety of art forms.
