

PAINTER CRAFTSMAN I

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

Semiskilled work performing a variety of painting and plastering tasks in the maintenance of school buildings and related facilities.

ESSENTIAL TASKS

(These are intended only as illustrations of the various types of work performed. The omission of specific duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related, or a logical assignment to the position.)

- Operate, maintain and repair tools and equipment associated with trade.
- Aid in reading and interpreting blueprints, plans, drawings and specifications.
- Assist with part and material procurement.
- Handle two-way communication with dispatch, other craftsmen, supervisor and administrative staff.
- Maintain safe and orderly work space.
- Operate work vehicle and ensure it is maintained and well stocked.
- May assume Painter Craftsman II or Painter Craftsman III responsibilities in their absence.
- Perform related work as required.

Painter Craftsman I

- Assist in the preparation and painting of finished surfaces in school buildings.
- Use brush, roller or airless sprayer to prep/paint surfaces.
- Apply stains and polyurethane.

Plasterer-Painter Craftsman I

- Assist in the repair, modification, and construction of plaster/drywall and related structures in school buildings.
- Aid craftsman II and III with the following; perform metal stud framing, hang sheetrock/blue board, perform finishing of sheetrock, mix and apply plaster finishes, install suspended ceilings, apply paints, stains and polyurethane when necessary.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

General knowledge of the safe use, operation and preventive maintenance of painting equipment; general knowledge of the necessary safety precautions associated with the work; skill in the use of painting and plastering materials and equipment; ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions; ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with associates.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

High School Diploma/GED and some painting experience.
A comparable amount of training and experience may be substituted for the minimum qualifications.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

Significant standing, walking, moving, climbing, carrying, bending, kneeling, crawling, reaching, handling, pushing, and pulling. Ability to lift 50 lbs.
Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential tasks.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

Possession of a valid driver's license.
