

PLUMBING CRAFTSMAN III

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

Perform difficult skilled work in the maintenance, repair, modification and installation of plumbing fixtures in school buildings and facilities. Perform technical work planning and supervise personnel as assigned.

ESSENTIAL TASKS

(These are intended only as illustrations of the various types of work performed. The omission of specific duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related, or a logical assignment to the position.)

- Supervise, when assigned, the installation, repair and maintenance of water, plumbing and heating systems.
- Assume the role of supervisor or designee in his absence; to include planning, scheduling, assigning, and supervising the activities of plumbers.
- Provide information for reports and charts concerning worker utilization and job time rates.
- Maintain high work standards, production control, job priorities and schedule preventative maintenance.
- Make sketches for plumbing layout and determine types and quantities of materials necessary.
- Determine time and cost estimates for plumbing jobs.
- Aid in obtaining materials necessary to complete the job.
- Assist staff with more difficult and complex projects.
- Assist skilled workers of related trades in general plumbing maintenance work.
- Maintain plumbing tools and equipment.
- Perform related work as required.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

Thorough knowledge of the common practices, tools and terminology of the plumbing trade; thorough knowledge of the use and characteristics of common plumbing equipment; thorough knowledge of the hazards and safety precautions associated with the plumbing trade; skill in the use of tools and equipment; ability to work from sketches, drawings, plans or specifications; ability to follow oral and written instructions; ability to plan and supervise the work of others; ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with associates.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

Graduation from high school and considerable plumbing experience. Master plumber's card and some supervisory experience preferred.

A comparable amount of training and experience may be substituted for the minimum qualifications.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

Significant standing, walking, moving, climbing, carrying, bending, kneeling, crawling, reaching, handling, pushing, and pulling. Ability to lift up to 75 lbs.

Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential tasks.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

Possession of a valid driver's license.
