October 15 - 31, 2018	<b>Fall SOL Writing</b> (Online)	
November 26 - December 7, 2018	<b>Fall SOL Writing</b> (Online) Second Opportunity	Students who were term graduates for the fall SOL test administration who need the writing SOL test for verified credit; online testing only.
January 7 - 16, 2019	<b>Fall SOL Non-Writing</b> EOC* Non-Writing Tests Grade 8 Reading and Mathematics Tests	Students in EOC* classes; RRP students, and MSD** students under SOL requirements.
January 17 - February 1, 2019	<b>Fall SOL Non-Writing</b> Expedited EOC* Tests Expedited Grade 8 Reading and Mathematics Tests	Fall EOC*; MSD** students who meet the expedited testing requirements.
January 22 - March 28, 2019	<b>English Language Proficiency Test (ACCESS FOR ELLs)</b> Academic Language of the Content Areas (Reading, Writing, Listening, and Speaking)	All students designated with English proficiency levels 1.0-5.9.
February 20 - 22, 2019	<b>WorkKeys</b>	Students who passed the grade 11 English course and have taken and failed, at least once, the EOC* writing or reading SOL test. Students enrolled in a grade 11 English course and who are trying to graduate by June 2019.
March 4 - 8, 2019	<b>Spring SOL Writing</b> (Term Grad Paper/Pencil ) High School	Term Graduate high school students scheduled to graduate by August 2018 who need the writing SOL test for verified credit.
March 11 - 15, 2019	<b>Spring SOL Writing</b> (Term Grad Online) High School	
March 18 - 22, 2019	<b>Spring SOL Writing</b> Middle School	Students in grade 8 English classes.
March 11 - April 11, 2019	<b>Spring IPT</b>	Students in grades 4 and 7.
April 22 - 26, 2019	<b>Spring SOL Writing</b> (Online) Second Opportunity	Students who were term graduates for the spring SOL test administration who need the writing SOL test for verified credit; online testing only.
April 22 - May 3, 2019	<b>April Term Grad Testing</b>	Students in EOC* classes and MSD** students who will graduate by August 2019.

May 20 - 30, 2019	<b>Spring SOL Non-Writing</b> High School EOC* and Grade 8 Reading & Mathematics Tests	
May 20 - June 4, 2019	<b>Spring SOL Non-Writing</b> Middle School EOC* and Grades 6 - 8	
June 3 - 10, 2019	<b>Spring SOL - High School</b> Expedited EOC* Tests; Expedited Grade 8 Reading and Mathematics Tests	Spring EOC* and MSD** students who meet the expedited testing requirements.
June 5 - 13, 2019	<b>Spring SOL - Middle School</b> Expedited EOC* Tests	Spring EOC* students who meet the expedited testing requirements.
June 6 - 13, 2019	<b>Spring SOL - Elementary School</b> Expedited Tests	Spring SOL students who meet the expedited testing requirements.
